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“Veteran” is defined as “a person who served in the active military, naval, or air service, and who was discharged or released there from under conditions other than dishonorable.” The period of service must include service in active duty for purposes other than training. Active duty means full time duty in the active military service of US Title 10. Hence, the National Guard and Reserve Members must have been called into Federal Service, in order to be considered eligible for SSVF services. The goal of the SSVF Program is to promote housing stability among very low-income Veteran families who are currently homeless or at imminent risk of becoming homeless.

Short Term Program 30-90 days “*Veteran must Reside in or Move to Suffolk County*”
